

Simple Crocheted Nativity



Notes:

Pattern is worked in a continuous spiral without slip stitching to join unless otherwise noted in the pattern. Use a stitch marker at the end of each round to mark the beginning/end to round. When the pattern does call for slip stitching to join the first stitch of the next round is made in the same stitch as the joining slip stitch.

Pattern is written for use with worsted weight yarn. I have used Hobby Lobby's "I Love This Yarn – acrylic" but any worsted weight yarn can be substituted.

I am hoping to add a crochet angel, shepherd and lamb to the set soon so check back!

Pattern stitches:

Invdec: insert hook into front loops only of next 2 stitches, yarn over, pull through the 2 front loops, yarn over, pull through final 2 loops on hook.

Sc2tog: insert hook into stitch, pull up loop, insert into next stitch, pull up loop, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.

Although this is a FREE pattern a lot of time and love went into making it. Mary:

F hook

Worked in rounds with F hook:

1. With skin color: ch 2, sc 6 into first ch, (6)
 2. 2 sc in each sc. (12)
 - 3-5. sc in each sc **for 3 rounds**
Stuff head with fiber fill
 6. *invdec*6 times (6)
 7. With dress color slst to next st , ch 1, 2 sc in each sc (12)
 8. sc 4, 2 sc in next, sc 2, 2 sc in next, sc 4, (14)
 9. sc 5, 2 sc in next, sc 2, 2 sc in next, sc 5, (16)
 10. sc 4, *invdec* 4 times, sc 4, (12)
 11. *sc 2, invdec* 3 times (9)
 12. *sc 2, 2 sc in next* 3 times (12)
 13. *sc 3, 2 sc in next* 3 times (15)
 - 14-17. sc in each sc (15)
 18. *sc 2, 2 sc in next* 5 times, **slst to join** (20)
 19. Working in BLO **for this round only:** ch 1 *sc2tog* 10 times, join with slst(10)
Stuff body with fiberfill
 20. ch 1, *sc2tog* 5 times (5)
- Finishing: cut yarn leaving an 8 inch tail to sew hole close

Optional "base" to make them stand up better:

With same color attach yarn to one of the front loops of round 19, ch 1, *sc 2, 2 sc in next* 6 times, sc 1, 2sc in next, slst to join, finish off. Weave in all ends. (27)

Mary's head veil

F hook

Work in rows

1. Ch 21, sc in 2nd loop from hook and remaining 19 ch (20)
2. Turn, ch 1, sc in each sc (20)
3. Sc 8, *sc2tog* 2 times, sc 8 (18)
4. Sc 7, *sc2tog* 2 times, sc 7 (16)
5. Sc 6, *sc2tog* 2 times, sc 6 (14)
6. Sc 5, *sc2tog* 2 times, sc 5 (12)
7. Sew the first 6 stitches to the last 6 stitches (see photo)
PHOTO

Baby Jesus:

F hook

1. With skin color ch 2, 4 sc in first ch.
2. 2 sc in each sc (8)
3. Sc in each sc (8)
4. *invdec* 4 times (4)

5. With blanket color slst to next st , ch 1, 2 sc in each sc (8)
 - 6-10. sc in each sc (8)
 11. *sc2tog* 4 times (4)
- Finishing: cut yarn leaving an 8 inch tail to sew hole close

Manger:

G hook

1. With brown, ch 7, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc 4, 3 sc in last (working on opposite side of chain now), sc 4, slst to join to first st of round.
 2. Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as joining, 2 sc in next 2 stitches, sc 4, 2 sc in next 3 stitches, sc 4, slst to join to first st of round.
 3. Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, 2 sc in next, *sc 1, 2 sc in next* 2 times, sc 4, *sc 1, 2 sc in next* 3 times, sc 4, slst to join to first st of round.
 4. Slst around entire edge.
- Cut and weave in ends.

Man's figure:

F hook

1. With skin color: ch 2, sc 6 into first ch, (6)
 2. 2 sc in each sc. (12)
 - 3-5. sc in each sc (12)
- Stuff head with fiber fill*
6. *invdec*6 times (6)
 7. With body color slst to next st , ch 1, 2 sc in each sc (12)
 8. *sc 5, 2 sc in next* 2 times (14)
 - 9-19. sc in each sc (14)
 20. sc in each sc, slst to join (14)
 21. Working in BLO ch 1, *sc2tog* 8 times (7)
- Finishing: cut yarn leaving an 8 inch tail to sew hole close

Optional "base" to make them stand up better:

With same color attach yarn to one of the front loops of round 21, ch 1, *sc 2, 2 sc in next* 4 times, sc 1, 2sc in next, slst to join, finish off. Weave in all ends. (19)

Beard:

F hook

1. Ch 7, in 2nd stich from hook sc 2, ch2, sc 2
 2. Ch 1, turn, skip first 2 sc 4 sc into ch-2 space, skip next, slst into last sc.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Joseph's head cloth

G hook

1. With main color: ch 2, sc 6 into first ch, (6)
 2. 2 sc in each sc. (12)
 3. Sc in each sc (12)
 4. With accent color slst to next st to join, ch1, sc in same st as joining, sc in each st around. (12)
 5. With main color again slst to join, ch 1, sc in same and joining and next 8 st. (9)
 - 6-12. Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc around (9)
- Finish off and weave in ends

Wiseman #1 hat

F hook

1. With blue ch 2, 7 sc in first ch, slst to join (7)
2. Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc, slst to join (14)
3. Ch 1, in BLO sc in each sc around, slst to join (14)
4. Working in both loops again sc in each sc, slst to join (14)
5. Sc in each sc (14) with grey slst to join
6. Continuing with grey ch 1, **TURN** (working in **rows** now) sc in next 10 sc (10)
- 7-14. Ch1, turn, sc in each sc

Wiseman #2 hat:

F hook

1. With red ch 2, 7 sc in first ch (7)
 2. 2 sc in each sc (14)
 3. Sc in each sc (14)
 4. With gold slst in each sc
- Finish off

Wiseman #3 hat:

F hook

1. With purple ch 2, 6 sc in first ch (6)
 2. 2sc in each sc (12)
 3. *sc 1, 2 sc in next* 6 times (18)
 - 4-5. Sc in each sc (18)
 6. *sc 1, sc2tog* 6 times (12)
 7. with red slst around
- Finish off

Finishing set:

1. Embroider Mary's hair with brown yarn making sure that you go far enough back that the head covering will cover where your stitches are started.
2. Hot glue or sew all head coverings and hats onto the figures
3. Hot glue or sew beards onto the men
